90 % Rule

IT AFFECTS ALL STUDENTS.

A state law requires that students attend school for at least 90 percent of the days the class is offered. Otherwise, the student will not receive credit for the class.

The Board of Trustees of the El Paso Independent School District has been empowered to establish guidelines and appoint campus-based attendance committees which may consider extenuating circumstances and grant credit.

Parents should contact the school principal if they have questions or for additional information on the attendance requirement.
